7. Entries and Eligibility

- a) The Baltic Sail nations and cities are allowed to start with one team!
 - Teams shall consist of nominated sailors of the member cities of the BALTIC SAIL!
 - Nations: Germany, Poland, Lithuania, Sweden, Latvia, Denmark

- b) Registration
 - To remain eligible the entire crew has to complete the registration and provide a copy of a third party insurance certificate (race risk).
- c) No entry fee

- e) Damage Penalty:
 - A damage penalty of 500,00 € is agreed on by registration.
- f) Insurance
 - All competitors need to have adequate third party insurance-race risk.

8. Rules

The following rules should guide the event:

- a. The current ISAF (WR) 2013-2016, including addendum C
- b. The notice of race and sailing instructions, including amendments.
- c. Displaying Protest: Fixing Code flag Y and Code flag B to a stick and waving it.

9. Jury

A jury of referees will be appointed by the host-city. The right of decision will be denied.

10. Boats and Sails

- Every team is going to sail on Nordisk Folkebaad.
- 3 boats will be provided
- The following sails will be provided as well: Mainsail and Jib.
- Boats will be assigned by the Race Committee.

11. Crew

- a. The requested number of crew members (including the skipper) are 3 persons (male or female). The registered crews are supposed to sail all races.
- b. The maximum total crew weight is 285kg.
- c. When a registered skipper or crew member is unable to continue the event the Race Committee or jury may authorise an original crew member as substitute.

12. Event Format

- a. Every group will sail one or two Round Robin, followed by the finals.
- b. The RC is allowed to vary the format at any time, when conditions do not permit the completion of the intended format.

13. Course

- a. The intended up- and down- course will run along the not inscribed marks, normally resulting in starboard rounding.

14. Advertising

- a. In accordance with the ISAF Regulation 20.3.2 will be applied.
- b. Each boat has to display advertisement as required by the organising authority.
- c. Any advertisement displayed by competitors has to correspond to the boundary of the organising authority.
- d. Crews are not allowed to protest against any rules regarding the advertisement.

15. Prizes

The prizes will be announced in the skippers-meeting.

16. Award Ceremony

The award ceremony will take place after the last race on Saturday, 4th of August 2018.

17. Media

The organising authority is legitimate to use all images or recording produced during the whole event.
